Resume	A current academic and professional resume or vita is required including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● educational degrees; ● professional experience; ● all relevant awards, publications, presentations, or other achievements
Personal Goal Statement	A personal goal statement that addresses: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● reasons for seeking entry into this program; ● a minimum of 60 hours of experiences in professional or volunteer work, enrichment experiences, and/or post-baccalaureate coursework related to persons with disabilities (prefer six months of experience) ● highlight work with diverse communities
Personal History Statement	This is a statement for you to provide any additional information about your personal background that you feel is related to your interest in becoming a Special Education Teacher.
2 letters of recommendation	Detailing academic potential, leadership, collaboration, adaptability <i>If you are a working Instructional Assistant, one of the letters of recommendations must be from a direct supervisor.</i>
Unofficial transcripts from all schools attended	Unofficial transcripts should be uploaded in the online application
WEST-B	WEST-B subtests, reading, writing, and math, must be taken by the application deadline. ACT/SAT scores may substitute. Score reports can be uploaded in the application or official scores should be sent to the UW if unable to load them. If you are unable to schedule an exam due to COVID 19 closures, please note your plan to take it once test centers reopen. ACT: Contact Student Services Score Report (319-337-1270) to order a score report in addition to requesting your scores be sent to UW, Seattle. The cost is \$13 if you tested after 9/1/16, \$38 if you before 9/1/16. SAT: Call 866-756-7346 to request scores be sent to UW, Seattle, school code #4854. The cost is \$12 for the score report plus \$31 archive fee. Writing scores prior to 2005 cannot be used.
